This cause coming on to be hear on this ----- day of -----, 1922, a regular judicial day of the June, 1922 Term of said Court, upon the petition of plaintiff herein, and the defendant having been duly served with summons according to law, and he having failed to file answer to the plaintiff's petition herein; and the allegations contained therein must be taken as confessed and are true.

And the defendant having been called three times in open Court to answer, and comes not, but wholly makes default in this cause.

The Court having heard the oral testimony of witnesses duly sworn and examined in open Court, and on consideration thereof, finds that all the material facts alleged in plaintiff's petition are true; and further finds that the plaintiff is an actual resident of the State of Oklahoma in good faith, and being fully advised in the premises,

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by this Court, that the plaintiff is hereby granted a decree of divorce annulling the marriage relations that heretofore existed between the plaintiff, S. F. Smart, and the defendant Wm. Smart, and that plaintiff is hereby decreed to hold in her own right and title to the home place, the south fifty feet of Lot Two (2) and the North Twenty Five (25) feet of Lot Three (3) of the North Tulsa Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and said defendant is hereby forever barred and enjoined from interfering with the plaintiff and her possession of said above described real estate

It is further ORDERED that this Decree of Divorce does not become absolute and take effect for six months from date hereof.
