Reeves, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, on oath deposes and says: I am the grantee named in a certain assignment, dated June 24, 1922, and recorded in Book 406, at page 389, of the Records of the County Clerk, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and this affidavit is made for the purposes of clearing up any ambiguity or confusion with reference to the interest intended to be conveyed in and to the oil and gas mining rights in and to the :

Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twelve (12),

Township Eighteen (18), North, Range Twelve (12), East, Tulsa County,

Oklahoma.

by said assignment. It was intended between the Pyramid Petroleum Company and this affiant that said assignment was intended to convey and in fact did convey as to the said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter only an undivided one-fourth interest of the one-fourth interest in said oil and gas lease, held and owned by the said Company, an undivided three-fourths interest therein theretofore already having been contracted to be conveyed to O. W. West and G. J. Smith, in consideration of an agreement upon the part of the said West and Smith to drill and complete a well into the tank on said property. In other words, the Pyramid Petroleum Company conveyed to this affiant an undivided one-fourth interest in and to the oil and gas rights in and to all the property it owned and held in Section twelve (12), Township Eighteen (18), North, Range Twelve (12), East, in Tulsa County Oklahoma, but it was expressly understood and agreed that the Pyramid Petroleum Company owned and held the said oil and gas mining rights at that time in and to the southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter above described, subject to said drilling contract with West and Smith, but that it owned and held the entire seven-eighths working interest in and to the oil and gas mining rights in and to the other property described in said assignment, located in Section Twelve (12), Township Eighteen (18), North, Range Twelve (12), East, and that as to all of said property, except the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section, the Pyramid Petroleum Company intended to convey and the said George E. Reeves acquired by said assignment an undivided one-fourth interest therein, free and clear of any and all incumbrances of any kind or nature whatsoever.
