OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR
ALLOTMENT

CREEK NATION, OKLAHOMA

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into

in quadruplicate on this 1st day of June A. D. 1922, by and

between Sammie Naharkey, heir of Moses and Millie Naharkey, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, enrolled as a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 4365, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and Gladys Belle Oil Company, a corporation of Delaware, with one of its offices at Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved Mar 27, 1908. (35 Stat.L.P. 312) WITNESSETH:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease, and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 20; and the West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 35, of Section, Township 19 N, Range 12E, of the Indian Meridian, and containing 120 acres, more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store and remove oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much, only of the surface of said land as may reasonably be necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, and removing such oil and natural gas, also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land by means of pipe lines or otherwise, a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and also the right to use, free of cost, oil and natural gas as fuel so far as necessary to the development and operation of said property.
