RIGHT OF WAY CONTRACT

by admowledged, Sam Eaton and Ruby Eaton his wife hereafter called grantors, hereby grant unto SINCLAIR PIPE COMPANY, a Maine corporation, hereafter called grantee, the right to lay, maintain, inspect, operate, replace, change or remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and also the right to erect, install, maintain, inspect, operate and remove telegraph and telephone lines and the equipment and apparatus therefor if grantee desires to do so, to be used in connection with any pipe line hereafter constructed by said grantee on, over and through the following described land of which grantors warrant they are the owners in fee simple, situated in Tulsa County, State of Okla., to-wit:

SE4 OF SW4: Section 25, Township 22, Range 12 East

NE% of NW% Section 36. Township 22, Range 12 East together with the right of ingress and egress to and from said land for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise by said grantee of the rights granted by this contract.

And for an additional consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said grantors hereby grant unto said grantee the right at any time to lay, maintain, operate, inspect, replace, change or remove an additional pipe line or pipe lines alongside of said first pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas on, over and through said land, and grantee agrees to pay grantors for each additional pipe line placed on said land by it the sum of One Hundred pollars on or before the time grantee commences to construct such pipe line on, over and through said land.
