

any one of them, or by depositing such payment to the credit of said grantors or any one of them in the Oklahoma Nat Bank of Skiatook, Okla., and payment so made shall be deemed and considered as payment to each of said grantors; and that the terms, conditions and provisions of this contract shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
