THIS INDENTURE, Made this Twentieth day of September, 1922, between Eugene Wilson and his wife Mattie Wilson, in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and the FARM AND HOME SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF MISSOURI, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred DOLLARS, in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, CONVEY AND CONFIRM unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the following described real estate, lying and situated in the County of TULSA and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: A part of Lot number Two (2) in Block number Twenty Two (22) in the Town of North Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the Approved plat thereof, recorded, and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Easterly line of said Lot number Two (2), a distance of Twenty Five (25) feet Southerly from the Northeast corner thereof; thence along the Easterly line in a Southerly direction a distance of Fifty (50) feet; thence in a Westerly direction at right angles to the Easterly line of said Lot, a distance of Sixty (60) feet to the line dividing the Creek Nation from the Cherokee Nation; thence in a Westerly direction following the said dividing line to the Westerly boundary of said Lot Number Two (2); being a point in the Easterly line of the alley running through the said Block; thence in a Northerly direction along said alley line a distance of Sixteen and Four-Tenths (16.4) feet; thence at right angles in an Easterly direction a distance of One Hundred Forty (140) feet to the place of beginning.
