RELEASE OF MORTGAGE

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of September 1921, J. P. Shallenberger and Annie Laurie Shallenberger, his wife as mortgagors made, executed and delivered to Tulsa Building and Loan Association, a corporation, as mortgagee, a certain mortgage to secure the payment of an indebtedness in amount of \$5000.00 covering the following described real estate situated in the county of TULSA State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned, TULSA BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation, being the successor to and formerly Tulsa Union Loan and Savings Association, mortgagee in the above described mortgage, does hereby discharge and release the premises aforesaid from the lien of the said mortgage, and does hereby fully satisfy the said mortgage of record.
