TRUST DEED

This Indenture, made this 15th day of May, A. D., 1922, by and between the NIXON OIL COMPANY, a corporation, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the state of Oklahoma, located and having its principal office in the city of Tulsa, county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and the (title Guarantee & Trust Company, as trustee, for the purposes hereinafter set forth,) party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, Whereas the said party of the first part desires to raise money for the purpose of discharging or paying certain debts against said corporation, heretofore necessarily incurred in its business, and to borrow money for the transaction of its business and for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges and franchises, and for other lawful purposes has, by a resolution of its board of directors, authorized the making and issuing of its negotiable coupon bonds, each of the denomination of \$1,000.00, numbered consecutively from 1 to 125, and to bear date on 15th day of May, 1922, payable ten years from date in gold coin of the United States of the present standard of weight and fineness and bearing interest at the rate of 5 per cent per annum, payable in like gold coin semi-annually on the first days of November and May of each year; and

WHEREAS, all of said bonds are to be sealed with the corporate seal of said Nixon Oil Company, signed by its president and secretary, with the certificate of the trustee hereunder endorsed thereon, and each of said coupon bonds to have interest coupons attached, which said bonds, coupons and certificates are all to be substantially of the following tenor, to wit:
