

to the Secretary of the Interior as herein provided shall cease, and all payments required to be made to said Superintendent for the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskogee, Oklahoma, shall thereafter be made to lessor or the then owner of said lands in person or be deposited to the credit of said lessor or his assigns at the -----Bank of----- or such other place as the said lessor or his assigns may from time to time designate in writing, and changes in regulations thereafter made by the Secretary of the Interior applicable to oil and gas leases shall not apply to this lease.

13. Each and every clause and covenant in this indenture shall extend to the heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and lawful assigns of the parties hereto.
