COMPARED OIL AND GAS KEASE

Know all men by these presents: That J. M. Crutchfield and Nell D. Crutchfield, his wife of the Postoffice of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, hereinafter called lessor (whether one or more) for and in consideration of one and no/100 dollars, cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby lease unto The Texas Company, a corporation of Texas, hereinafter called lessee, the following described land, situated in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma:
