DECLARATION OF HEIRSHIP

Gubser, being first duly sworn depose and say: That I am now and have been for the eighteen years last past, a resident of the aforesaid State and County ever since Statehood and was a resident of said city and place at the time it was a portion of the Indian Territory, during all of said time I was of legal age and that I was County Judge of Tulsa County, Oklahoma for five years of said time, That I was well and personally acquainted with Mrs. Sarah E. Marshall from the year 1903 up to the time of her death in the year 1918, the same being a period of fifteen years. That the said Sarah E. Marshall was at the time of her death the owner in fee simple, title of the following real estate situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
