1st, I direct the payment of all my just debts.

2, I give and bequeath to my wife Almina Cover, lot 1, block 4 Replat block 4, Haynes and Weimer add. - our present home and furniture for and during her natural life only, also \$200.00 per month to be paid her during her natural life. Then payment to cease and the home to revert to my children.

To my 4 children, Chas. H. Cover, Mayme Gibson nee Cover, John V. Cover and Caroline ^S Cover I give and bequeath the sum of \$75.00 per month each during the lifetime of my wife Almina Cover, at Almina Cover's death I desire that my estate be divided equally as may be between my four children. Not sold. I hereby appoint Chas. H. Cover and John Price my administrators to give bond Chas. H. Cover to give all his time to care of property, for which he shall receive in addition to bequest \$150.00 per mo. This shall not be construed to mean that he cannot trade ~~outside~~ outside of the estate for himself.

Should any beneficiary under this will contest the same in that event party socontesting to receive \$50.00 in lieu of his ~~own~~ bequest.
