PETITION FOR THE PROBATE OF WILL.

Come now Charles H. Cover and John A. Price and respectfully represent and show
to the court as follows:

That C. E. Cover departed this life at Okmulgee in Okmulgee County, Oklahoma,
on the 10 day of June 1920.

That C. E. Cover at the time of his death was a resident of said Okmulgee Coun-
ty, Oklahoma, had made his home therein for many years just previous to his death and
left an estate in said county and adjoining counties consisting of farm lands and city
property of the probable value of two hundred fifty thousand dollars.

That said deceased left a will bearing date of January 6, 1920 which is now
in the possession of these petitioners and which they believe and allege to be the last
will and testament of said deceased, a copy of which will is hereto attached and marked
"Exhibit A" and the same is herewith presented for probate.

That Charles H. Cover and John Price, whose full name is John A. Price are the
persons named in said will as executors and are residents of Okmulgee County, Oklahoma,
are the petitioners herein and consent to act as executors.

That the names, ages and residence of the heirs, devisees and legatees of
of said deceased are as follows, Almina Cover, age 53, Charles H. Cover, age 30 years,
Mayme M. Gibson age 26 years, John V. Cover, age 20 years and Caroline S. Cover, age
18 years, all of whom have their residences at and reside in Okmulgee, Okmulgee County,
Oklahoma.

Your petitioners further state that they are interested in said estate as
follows; that said Charles H. Cover is an heir and devisee of C. E. Cover and that both
petitioners are named as executors in said will.

Wherefore petitioners pray the court that a day be fixed for hearing this
petition and notice thereof given as required by law, and that upon final hearing
hereof, that said will be admitted to probate, and letters testamentary be issued thereon
to Charles H. Cover and John A. Price and that the court make such other and further
orders, in the premises as may be just.
