

That the last will and testament of the said C. E. Cover, deceased, executed on the 6th day of January, 1920, being void under the statutes of the State of Oklahoma, as provided under section 8341, Revised Laws 1910, as against the undersigned in so far and to the extent that it purports to bequeath away more than two-thirds of the property and estate consisting for the most part of farm lands city property, and oil production, amounting in value to in excess of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand (\$250,000) dollars, belonging to said deceased, the undersigned elects not to take under said will but to take under the provisions of the Statute of Oklahoma, as therein and thereby provided, including her inheritance homestead rights and allowances.

STIPULATION AND SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this 18 day of May, 1922, by and between Charles H. Cover, John V. Cover, Mayme Gibson and Caroline S. Payne nee Cover, parties of the first part and Almina Cover, widow, party of the second part, the parties hereto being the sole and only heirs at law of C. E. Cover, deceased.

WITNESSETH: That whereas Almina Cover has heretofore filed her election to take under the law as the widow of C. E. Cover, deceased instead of under the will the parties hereto have on this day in settlement of her property interests in the estate of said deceased executed to her and delivered a quit claim deed to certain properties and she has executed to parties of the first part her quit claim deeds and has delivered them to certain other properties and assignments dividing the oil and gas royalties between the parties hereto have also been executed between said parties in settlement of all their claims in and to said properties so conveyed and assigned, reference to which assignments and deeds so executed is hereby made for a more specific description thereof.

Now therefore in settlement of all their other property rights in full subject to the settlement of the administration the payment of the Federal and State inheritance taxes and the gross production tax by the executors of the C. E. Cover estate herein, it is agreed that the executors herein shall pay to Almina Cover out of the funds now in their hands the sum of Forty five hundred (\$4500.00) dollars, and that she shall have and take an undivided one fourth interest in lot four (4) of Block eighty eight (88) of the original town of Okmulgee, Oklahoma and that the parties hereto shall sell the home place, lot one (1) of block four (4) of replat
