know all men by these presents, that the undersigned are the owners of an oil and gas lease in, and described as follows:

- \* The north half of the northeast quarter of section 28 township 19 north, range 14 east, Tulsa County, Okla. and containing 80 acres more or less.

That we are selling certain undivided interests in said lease, subject to the following terms, conditions and reservations.

1. We, the assignors, bind ourselves to drill a test well on said premises to a depth of 1400 feet, unless oil or gas is found in paying quantities at a lesser depth.
2. Our contract, as outlined, in #1 shall be completed when said test attains a depth of 1400 feet, or when a <sup>pay sand</sup> pay is encountered.
3. No transfer of any interest in equipment is contemplated, and upon striking a pay sand, each and every owner from that time on, is to bear his proportionate part of the necessary and actual expenses incurred in the bringing in and equipping said well, and the administering and operating of said lease.
4. The administration of the lease, and its operation, shall be in accordance with the will of the owners of more than one half of the working interest of said lease, or a trustee or trustees appointed by them, and same shall have the authority to sell oil or gas from lease on contracts that seem most advantageous and profitable.
5. Owners of interest shall receive their proportionate part of the money derived from the sale of oil or gas from said premises, direct from the buyers.
