

for the use and benefit of the association and all, the shareholders thereof.

The trustees shall have the power to delegate the signing of stock certificates to employees they may ~~so~~ designate, and shall have the power to declare dividends upon our standing shares as in their judgement seems proper.

The shares herein mentioned shall be fully paid and nonassessable, and the trustees are hereby prohibited from creating any debts and obligations for or on behalf of said association which shall be in excess of the capital for the liquidation thereof.

No shareholder shall be liable for the amount greater than his or her subscription to the association, this being the sole extent of his or her contribution.

This association shall exist for a period of twenty five years (25).

A majority of the shareholders at any regular or special meeting thereof shall constitute a quorum, and a majority of these present by person or proxy, shall be empowered to take action not inconsistent with this trust agreement

An increase in the number of ^{shares or} decrease thereof may be declared subject to the approval of the majority of the shareholders at any special or regular meeting.
