

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the services of the said Kanola Oil & Refining Company, and the said H. M. Baker, as above stated, and hereby acknowledged, to have been performed for the undersigned Noco-Mexican Oil Company, a corporation.

The said Noco-Mexican Oil Company does hereby promise, covenant and agree to render the said Kanola Oil & Refining Company and H. M. Baker, itemized statements of all expense and income at lease every 60 days from the above date, and to pay the said Kanola Oil & Refining Company and said H. M. Baker, each and severally the one-eighth (1/8) part of all the profits derived from said lease by the reason of the sale of said lease, or by reason of the sale of oil or gas, or casinghead gasoline, or any other oil and gas product or by-product sold from said lease or otherwise.
