his heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey  
unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his  
right, title, interest, estate claim and demand both at law and equity in and to all the  
following described property, to-wit:

Lots 8, 9 and 10 in Block 1, in Park Hill an addition to the City  
of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the duly recorded  
plat thereof

This quit claim deed is given to correct an improper acknowledgement to a warranty deed
