

along the extension of the East line of said lot 1, Block 3, a distance of 7' (seven feet) and 6" (six inches) running thence in a westerly direction and parallel with the north line of said lot 1, block 3, a distance of 155' (one hundred fifty five feet) and 5" (five inches) running thence in a Southerly direction to the point of beginning, and said strip of land is hereby maintained by the City of Tulsa, upon which said City of Tulsa, may allow public service corporations, companies, individuals or itself to construct, maintain and operate facilities for public utilities and including poles, wires, pipes, conduits and other necessary accessories; and

Provided, further that the above vacation is made subject to the conditions and provisions of Paragraph 11, section 6, Article 11 of the Charter of the City of Tulsa.

Section 2: That all ordinances or partes of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance insofar as such conflict exists are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public welfare and safety by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

Passed, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved, this 26th day of September, 1922.

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COMPARED RENT CONTRACT.

This contract, made and entered into this 25th day of August, A.D. 1922, by and between Rollie Sarty of Wagoner County, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Jas. F. Secrest, of Coweta, Oklahoma, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein-after made and set forth, the said party of the first part, this day and by these presents does demise and let to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, for farming purposes, for a term of five years, from the 25th day of August, 1922, the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit.

The west one half of the north east quarter and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section twenty two (22) township eighteen (18) north, range thirteen (13) east, containing 1.0 acres more or less according to the survey thereof.
