This indenture of lease, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 10th day of August, A.D. 1922, by and between Malissa Burgess, a single woman, of Broken Arrow, Okla, entolled as a $\frac{1}{2}$ blood citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 874, party of the first part hereinafter designated as lessor, and W. B. Pine and D. M. Smith of Okmulgee, Okla. party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (35 Stat. L.P. 312) Witnesseth:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessees does hereby ^{demise} grant, lease and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section 17, township 13, range 14, of the Indian Meridian, and containing 40 acres, more or less, with the exclusive right to prospect for,
