Bruner of Tulsa, Okla. entitled as a Full-Blood Citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. 5813, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and R. E. Lynch of Tulsa, Okla. party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (35 Stat. L.R. 312) Witnesseth:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease and let unto the lessee, for the term of ten years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas or under
