Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Being Lots ten, eleven, twelve and Thirteen Block Two, City of Glenpool Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said F. Markle and his lawful wife M. J. Markle and M.T. Self and his lawful wife heirs, executors or administrators do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part that at the delivery of these presents there lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.
