To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said D. P. Kinsey his heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that he is lawfully seized in his own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT

Except a mortgage of \$7000. which grantees assume and agree to pay as part of purchase price.

and that he will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part of the second part their heirs and assigns against said part of the first part his heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
