presents it is lawfully seized in its  
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with  
the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judg-  
ments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.

A first mortgage in the sum of Thirty Five Hundred dollars (\$3500.00 in favor  
of the Home Building & Loan Association of Tulsa Oklahoma and special assessments  
hereafter to mature.

and that it will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns  
against said party of the first part its heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same.
