

Agreement

This memorandum of Agreement made and entered into on this 2nd day of June 1908 by and between Nath Argue - Maize Brothers Oil Company a corporation of Linn Ohio party of the first part and the Ovingo Oil and Gas Company a corporation of Linn Ohio party of the first part and the Ovingo Oil and Gas Company a corporation of Broken Arrow Oklahoma party of the second part. Witnesseth that whereas the party of the first part is the owner of the following described oil and gas mining lease on lands in the creek nation of the State of Oklahoma to wit:

A Lease executed by Charles F. Wright on the 2nd day of covering the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section eleven (11) Township nineteen north Range fourteen (14) east containing forty acres more or less in said nation and State.

A Lease covering what is commonly known as the New farm executed on the 25th day of June 1907, covering the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section fourteen (14) Township nineteen (19) north Range fourteen (14) east containing forty (40) acres more or less in said nation and State.

And whereas the party of the first part desires to have leases and certain lands in the vicinity thereof leased for oil and gas mining purposes

Now Therefore for and in consideration of the premises and the further stipulations of this contract it is understood and agreed between the parties as follows:

(1) That within thirty days from the date hereof, the party of the second part shall commence and complete on the lease east above mentioned and described in oil or gas well at a location 50 feet from the north line of said Lease and not more than 100 feet from the northwest corner of the tract covered by said lease, said well to be drilled to a depth
