

Agreement.

This Agreement, made and entered into this 14th day of September, 1908, by and between H. M. Morgan, of Muskogee, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and John S. Thomason and Morris T. Knight, of Vinita, Oklahoma, parties of the second part. Witnesseth:

That whereas H. M. Morgan, J. T. Colt and W. L. Maye are the owners of Commercial oil and gas leases in and to the following described land, to wit: NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of section seventeen (17) and NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of section sixteen (16) and (N 1/2 of NW 1/4, NW 1/4 of section twentyone (21), Township twenty (20) north range thirteen (13) east) containing 110 acres more or less. and whereas said first party is desirous of transferring all his right title and interest in and to said property to the said second parties herein, and said second parties are desirous of purchasing the same. Now, Therefore, the first party, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred sixty six and 66/100 (\$666.66) Dollars to him in hand paid by second parties the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign and convey unto the parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, an undivided one third interest in and to the oil and gas commercial leases held by said H. M. Morgan, J. T. Colt and W. L. Maye as aforesaid, on the above described property.
