

Oil and Gas Mining Lease
From Series 1908, approved April 20-1908

Oil and Gas Mining Lease upon land selected for allotment. Creek Nation Oklahoma.

This document of lease made and entered into in quadruplicate on the 2nd day of August A.D. 1908, by and between Wm. H. Brown, and Jennie Brown, heirs of Emanuel Brown, died of Tulsa Oklahoma, full blood citizens of the Creek Nation, party of the first part hereinafter designated as lessor and W. A. Springer and E. R. Whittell of Tulsa Oklahoma party of the second part hereinafter designated as lessee, understand as purchasers of the provisions of the act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 142) entitled

"The Leases for and in consideration of one dollar the receipt whereof is acknowledged and of the royalties consent stipulation and condition hereinafter contained and hereby agreed to be paid observed and performed by the lessee hereinafter demise ground lease in let unto the lessee for the term of five years from the date of the approval hereby the Secretary of the Interior and is much longer hereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land lying and being within the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit: N38° E of 79 E 1/2 and E 2 of 79 E 1/2 of 91 E 1/2 and 70 E 1/2 Sec 6, and Lots 2, 3 & 4 of Section 5 Township 19 N, Range 12 E, of the Indian Nation and containing 168.22 acre more or less and the exclusive right to prospect for extract, pipe stone and various oil and natural gas and to occupy and use so much only of the surface said land as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for extracting, pumping, storing, and securing such oil and natural gas, also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land by means of pipe lines or otherwise as sufficient supply of water to carry on said
