

Release of Mortgage

Now all men by these presents: That whereas on the 23rd day of January, 1917, a certain instrument of mortgage was made by and into by and between W. L. Early, married, H. A. Smith, and Lulu Smith, his wife, of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory (Mar. C. K.), mortgagee, parties of the first part, and Lynde-Brownman-Barby Company, a corporation of Kansas, and T. W., party of the second part covering the following described lands, to-wit:

The south half (1/2) of the southeast quarter (1/4) and the southeast quarter (1/4) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of section two (2), and the west half (1/2) of the southeast quarter (1/4) of section twelve (12) all in township nineteen (19) south, range fourteen (14) east, Now-Tulsa County, Oklahoma (Formerly, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, and

Whereas, said mortgage was executed and delivered to secure an indebtedness in the sum of two hundred fifty one and 11/100 (\$251.11) dollars, from the parties of the first part to the party of the second part, this being a second mortgage, and

Whereas, said mortgage was filed for record in the office of the Clerk of the said Court, at Tulsa, Indian Territory, on February 13, 1917, at 11:15 o'clock P. M. and duly recorded in Vol. 17, Page 446, in which said records have since been transferred to the

Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, at Tulsa, Oklahoma. Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of \$250.11, in hand paid to said party of the second part, by said parties of the first part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said party of the second part hereby releases, quitsclaim and assigns unto the said parties of the first part, all its rights, title and interest in and to the above described land, under and by virtue of said mortgage, with the intent and purpose of discharging said mortgage and incumbrance and thereby acknowledging satisfaction in full of said indebtedness.

In witness whereof, the said Lynde-Brownman-Barby Company has hereunto moved its corporate seal to be affixed and thereunto to be signed by its President, and attested by its Secretary, at Muskogee, Oklahoma, this 9th day of November, 1918.
