This Substantive made this 17th day of September, nineteen hundred and eight by and between Elmer M. Jones and Wallace S. Longhair wife of the County of Creek, State of Oklahoma, hereinafter called the party of the first part, and the Alliance Trust Company, limited of Denver, Colorado, hereinafter called the party of the second part, at corporation by and parties hereto admitted to be duly qualified and licensed to do this business in the State of Oklahoma, heretofore.

That whereas, the party of the first part is jointly indebted unto the said party of the second part in the sum of eight hundred dollars, as is evidenced by one promissory note of even date herewith, becoming due and payable, together, one note for eight hundred dollars due October first, 1913, with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum payable semi-annually in the first days of April and October in each year, as specified by interest coupons, said interest to be paid at the rate of eight per cent per annum of the maturity, and are payable to said second party, or order at the office of the Alliance Trust Company, limited, in Denver City, Colorado, in the full and true payment of principal, interest and expenses.

Now, therefore, the said first party in consideration of the sum of one dollar for the purpose of securing the indebtedness of said first party to said second party, well and lawfully made the following deed of land and premises, situate in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to wit: The north half of section west quarter and southeast quarter of southeast quarter section fourteen (14) Township 15 North (12) Range 15 East (13) It have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereto
