

Order.

In The County Court Of Tulsa County,
State of Oklahoma.

In the matter of the alienation of the allotment of Reuben Kelly and Mary Kelly, deceased, by Daniel Barnett.

Now, on this the 26th day of October, 1908, this matter came on to be heard, upon the petition of Daniel Barnett, praying for an order of this Court approving a certain deed by him executed, as one of the heirs of Mary Kelly and Reuben Kelly, deceased, thereby conveying this interest in and to the lands below described to Charles Page & A. G.ault.

The petitioner appearing in person and by his attorneys, Abbott & Brown and the Court after hearing the testimony of the petitioner and witnesses and the argument of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That the allegations in the petition contained are true; that the said Mary Kelly, deceased and Reuben Kelly, deceased were full blood Creek Indians and duly enrolled as such; that there was allotted to the said Mary Kelly the following described land, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The west half of the south west quarter and Lot 8, in section 9, and the east half of the south east quarter and Lot 7, in section 8, all in Township 19 north, range 12 east.

and there was allotted to the said Reuben Kelly the following described land, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma to-wit:

The southwest quarter of section 17, Township 19 north, range 12 east, and that the said Mary Kelly and the said Reuben Kelly died seized of the above described lands, as set out respectively.

The Court further finds that the said Mary Kelly died on or about the 1 day of , 1901, and that the said Reuben Kelly died on or about the 1 day of , 1903,
