Grazing Lease

Cherokee Nation Oklahoma

Transferable only with consent of the Secretary of
The Interior.

This Indenture made and entered into in good
replicate on this 17th day of Oct. A.D. 1908 by and
between Joe Black and of Barren Okla party of the
first part and C. L. Brown of Tulsa Okla party
of the second part under and in accordance with
the provisions of existing law and the rules and
regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior
relative to grazing leases in the Cherokee Nation
Oklahoma, Witnesseth That said party of the first
part for and in consideration of the covenants to it,
the said party of the second part having in set forth
done by these presents lease to said party of the second
part for grazing purposes only the following described tract
of land lying and being within the limits of the nation
and within the State of Oklahoma to wit: -

The SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 22 of Township
14 N. E. of the Indian Meridian and containing 40 acres
more or less for the full term of 10 years from date
