And that on the said 12th day of February, 1908, the said County Court made an order that the next of kin of said minors and all persons interested in the said estate appear in said Court on the 14th day of March, A.D. 1908 at 1:30 o'clock P.M. to show cause why or why not an order should not be granted for the sale of said real estate, and that a copy of said order be published three successive weeks before the day of hearing in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper printed and published in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that a copy of said order was so published, in said newspaper for the period of three weeks before said hearing, proof of publication of said notice being made by William Stryker, the Editor of said paper and filed in said Court on the 14th day of March, 1908, that on the said 14th day of March, 1908, on the hearing of said application to sell the said County Court found it to be to the best interests of said minors that their interests in said real estate be sold and made an order that said real estate be sold at public or private sale to the highest bidder and that notice of the time and place of said sale be given by publication one week in the Tulsa Democrat, a newspaper published at Tulsa in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and that the said guardian execute an additional bond to the State of Oklahoma in the penal sum of Four thousand dollars (\$4000.00) and that on the 1st day of April, 1908, the said guardian did give said bond in said sum, which was filed and approved by said Court on the 1st day of April, 1908.

That on the 24th day of August, 1908, the said guardian made application to said County Court.
