 Order of Approval.
 In the matter of the application of the full blood heirs of Jennie Archilla deceased, for approval of deed of lands of deceased.

And now, to wit on this 5th day of December, 1908, the above entitled matter coming on for hearing before me in open court on the application of Nellie Budder and Sallie Blackbar for approval of deed selling and conveying the lands of Jennie Archilla deceased the Court finds:

That Jennie Archilla was a full blood Cherokee Indian, that she departed this life on the 14th day of November, 1908, that at the time of her death she was a widow; that at the time of her death the said Jennie Archilla resided in Delaware County, Oklahoma and that she died within said County; That the sole and only heirs of the said Jennie Archilla are the petitioners herein Nellie Budder and Sallie Blackbar her daughters; that the said Jennie Archilla has no other children living or otherwise; that each of said children above named are adults; that Nellie Budder is the wife of Jack Budder and Sallie Blackbar is the wife of a Blackbar.

That said children are full bloods, that they have no personal property which they can sell and that their lands are not subject to alienation; that said heirs are in need of money for their support and maintenance; that at the time of her death the said Jennie Archilla was the owner of the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma to wit: The west half of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter and the east half of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, all in section nineteen (19), township twenty (20), north range thirteen (13) east, of the Indian Meridian.
