

Grant

In consideration of Ten x .00 Dollars this day paid to Bruce Brown English & husband Claude English, by the Gulf Pipe Line Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged we do hereby grant and convey unto said Gulf Pipe Line Company its successors and assigns the right to locate, maintain and operate a pipe line for the purpose of conveying of oil over through and upon that certain tract of land situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma and there described: To-wit: east quarter 22 T. 18 N. R. 12 E., also there is hereby granted, a right to erect and maintain a telegraph and telegraph line. The rights herein granted shall permit the use of such land as may be necessary for said pipe line for said telegraph and telephone line and shall also permit the grantee herein its successors and assigns to do whatever may be necessary to their construction or for the enjoyment of the rights herein granted including the right of ingress and egress and from said tract of land for the purpose of laying maintaining and restoring of said pipe line and said telegraph and telephone line and for removing of same when desired by the grantee its successors and assigns.

To Have and to hold the said Gulf Pipe Line easement unto the said Gulf Pipe Line Company its successors and assigns so long as the same shall be useful for the purpose desired of by said grantee, which by the acceptance hereof consent and agree with the grantor that the pipe line shall be buried so as not to interfere with the cultivation of the same.

It is understood that the person receiving this right of way for said company is authorized authoritatively to make any agreement consent or promise in its behalf and herein specifically shown and the same must be delivered and accepted upon the
