Real Estate Mortgage Note.

On the first day of October 1907, for value received we promise to pay to the order of the Inter State Mortgage Trust Company, the principal sum of Seventy five Dollars with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per year from Maturity hereof until paid, payable semi annually, both principal and interest payable at the office of The Inter State Mortgage Trust Company, Parsons, Kansas.

And if default be made in the payment of said note or secured, or any part of it, at the same maturity for the space of thirty days, or if the maker of the note shall allow the taxes or any other public rates and assessments on the property or any part thereof given as security for the aforesaid note to become delinquent or in case any taxes or assessments shall be levied against the holder of the note on account of this loan, or shall do any act whereby the value of said mortgaged property shall be impaired, then, upon the happening of any of said contingencies the whole amount herein secured shall at once be and become due and payable at the election of the legal holder of the note, and the Mortgager, legal representatives, or assigns, of said Mortgager, may proceed at once to exact this note and foreclose the mortgage given to secure said note and sell the mortgaged property to satisfy said debt, interest, and costs, and all taxes, public rates or assessments that may be due thereon shall be secured by mortgagor also included in judgment in such foreclosure case.
