C. C. Hall } Order of Confirmation

W. 187 } In the matter of the estate of
 the County Court of Wilbur Emory Campbell, deceased.

State of Oklahoma, County of Tulsa.

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on the 17th day of June, 1908, that on the 5th day of June, 1908, Emily M. Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land therein described; and,

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 5th day of June, 1908, the Court made an order setting the 17th day of June, 1908, for the hearing of said petition, and said order required the publication of notice of said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the said 17th day of June, 1908; and,

It further appearing to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent, the said will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the 10th day of December, 1907, the executrix Emily M. Campbell the petitioner aforesaid, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decedent as in her seeming fit and proper; and,

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will the said executrix, Emily M. Campbell, sold to C. C. Hall Lot 11 in Block 1 of the Great Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the sum of \$500; and,

It further appearing to the Court that no special mode of sale was required by said will of the said decedent, and that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted; that the sum paid was more than 90% of the appraised value of said lot, and that no greater sum than above specified could be obtained; and,

It further appearing to the Court that the said executrix filed her return of said proceedings to said sale
