Deed of Mortgage

Show all men by these presents:

Thomas, Daughter 18th day of September, 1899, a certain mortgage was executed by Louis B. Botsch mortgagee to Rachel Congman mortgagee for the amount of five hundred dollars upon the following described real estate to wit: Lot fourteen (14) in Block eighty nine (89) in the original town of Cedar, Tucker County, West Virginia, said real estate being encumbered with said mortgage as follows: a certain Marie Street in Cedar, W.
