Now all men by these presents: That the City National Bank of Tulsa, Indian Territory, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the National Banking Laws of the United States hereafter known as the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations paid to it by L. D. Lewis, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, remises, releases, sells, conveys and quitclaims unto the said L. D. Lewis the following described real estate situated in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot fourteen (14) in Block eighty nine (89) formerly denominated as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east side of Main Street, just thirty feet north of the corner of the block known as the Bryman corner, and running thence east 140 feet to the alley, thence north 24 feet, thence west 40 feet to Main Street, thence along Main Street 25 feet to place of beginning, in the town of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory.

To have and to hold unto the said L. D. Lewis.
