Tuttle and his wife Mary Ellen Tuttle, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, all the right title, interest claim or demand whatsoever it may have acquired in through or by certain mortgages bearing date of ^{November 20th 1905} ~~January 20th 1906~~ recorded in the office of Register of Deeds at Sapulpa Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) in Book B at page 21, to the premises herein described as follows:

The south twenty five (25) feet of Lot number six (6), and the north fifty (50) feet of Lot number five (5) all in block number one hundred and eighty three (183) according to the official government plat of Tulsa Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma) and all improvements thereon.
