\$425.00 For value received I promise to pay A. Y. Boswell on or before the 7 day of Jan. and 1909, the sum of Four Hundred twenty five & 00/100 dollars at his office in Tulsa Indian Territory with 8-2 interest thereon from maturity until paid, the maker of this note hereby agrees that until this note and all other payments agreed upon for one Solitary Diamond ring set in Tiffany mounting, have been made with interest as above, the title and ownership to this property shall be and remain in A. Y. Boswell. If this, or any payment agreed upon be not ^{at} maturity, then upon demand all the payments are to be considered as due and A. Y. Boswell or his agents may either enforce payment therefor enter the premises of any one holding or claiming said diamond ring and seize and remove it, and any amounts heretofore paid shall be considered as liquidated damages for past use and wear thereof.

The maker of this note also agrees to keep the said diamond ring in good order and not to remove it from its present location without the written consent of A. Y. Boswell.
