## Quit Claim Grant

Know all men by these presents that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred twenty five dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Hon. Rowl Bailey and Ernest L. Spitzer of Muskogee, Oklahoma, do hereby quit claim, release and assign to Okla Oil Company, a corporation organized under the laws in force in the Indian Territory and abiding business in the state of Oklahoma, all our rights, title and interest in the following described land in the County of Tucker, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: The southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section fifteen, township seven north, range twelve east, containing forty acres and being the homestead allotment of Elgin Kirby, deceased, and also the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section fifteen, and the north half of the northwest quarter twenty two and a half in Township seven north, range twelve east being the surplus allotment of said Elgin Kirby deceased, the said lands having been allotted to Elgin Kirby, deceased, as a duly enrolled citizen of the Creek Nation, and patented to the heirs of said Elgin Kirby by patent executed by the Principal Chief of the Muskogee Nation on March 26, 1904 and duly approved by them. O. W. Hitchcock, Secretary of the Interior, on April 25, 1904. To have and to hold our interest in the said premises unto the said grantee, its heirs and assigns forever. Signed and delivered this 1st day of July, 1908.
