

Order Of Confirmation.

State Of Oklahoma } ss. In the County Court
County of Tulsa } No. 187.

In the matter of the estate of Wilbur Emory Campbell, deceased.

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on this 6th day of June, 1908, that on the 25th day of May, 1908, Emily M. Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described; and,

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 25th day of May, 1908, the Court made an order setting the 6th day of June, 1908, for the hearing of said petition and in said order required the publication of notice of said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the said 6th day of June, 1908.

It further appearing to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent, the said will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the 10th day of December, 1907, the executrix, Emily M. Campbell, the petitioner aforesaid, was authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all of the real estate of said decedent, as to her seemed fit and proper; and,

It further appearing to the Court that in accordance with said power and authority given in said will, the said executrix, Emily M. Campbell, sold to Clara H. Black, Lots Five (5) and Six (6) in Block Two (2) of the D. D. Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the sum of \$825; and,

It further appearing to the Court that no special mode of sale was required by said will of the said decedent, and that said sale was legally made and fairly conducted, that the sum paid was more than 90% of the appraised value of said lot, and that no greater sum than above specified could be obtained; and,

It further appearing to the Court that the said executrix filed her return of said proceedings of said sale on the said 25th day of May, 1908, as
