

Release Of Mortgage.

Know all Men By These Presents:

That I, the undersigned owner, holder and mortgagee of a certain real estate mortgage executed to Mary J. Moore, on the 2nd day of January 1905, by Della Fulton and Marion J. Dillon, her husband, mortgagors to secure the principal sum of five hundred fifty and ^{no} 100 dollars principal and interest and whereby said mortgagors mortgaged to the said Mary J. Moore all the following described property situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to wit:

Commencing at the southwesterly corner of Block 93, running northerly along the easterly line of Edwood Avenue a distance of 150 feet; thence easterly on a line parallel with and 150 feet northerly from the northerly line of south second street, a distance of 45 feet; thence in a southerly direction on a line parallel with and 45 feet easterly from the easterly line of Edwood Avenue a distance of 150 feet; thence westerly along the northerly line of south second street a distance of 45 feet to the place of beginning, being apart of Lots 546 in Block 93 in the town of Tulsa Indian Territory (now State of Oklahoma), and which mortgage was duly filed for record in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court at Sapulpa Indian Territory and recorded in Book 2 at Page 352, on the 5th day of January 1905, do hereby acknowledge full payment of the debt secured thereby and do hereby release the same and quitclaim all right in said premises by virtue of said mortgage.
