

Grazing Lease, Cherokee Nation, Oklahoma.

Transferable only with the consent of the Secretary of the Interior.

This Indenture made and entered into, in quadruplicate, on this 11 day of Sept. A.D. 1908, by and between William H. Davis, Guardian, Cayhoka Sawney and Annie Sawney, minors of Stillwell, Okla. party of the first part, and C. G. Brown of Tulsa Okla. party of the second part, under and in accordance with the provisions of existing law and the rules and regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior relative to grazing leases in in the Cherokee Nation Oklahoma.

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the covenants of the said party of the second part, hereinafter set forth, does by these presents lease to said party of the second part, for grazing purposes only, the following described tract of land lying and being within the limits of the Cherokee Nation and within the state of Oklahoma to wit:

One $5\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $1/4$ and the N $1/2$ of the SW $1/4$ and the NW $1/4$ of the SE $1/4$ and the W $1/2$ of the SW $1/4$ of the NE $1/4$ of section 20, of township 22, of range 13 E. of the Indian meridian and containing acres, more or less, for the full term of 10 years from date hereof, and the said party of the second part, in consideration of said premises as above set forth covenants and agrees with the party of the first part to pay said party of the first part as rental for the same the sum of fifty five $\frac{55}{100}$ dollars per annum being at the rate of twenty five cents per acre payable as follows, to wit:

Payable on the first day of January of each year during the continuance of this lease.

Said party of the second part further covenants and agrees that at the expiration of the time mentioned
