ELEVENTH. This trust shall not continue in any event longer than for the term of five years, at which time the then Trustee shall proceed to wind up its affairs, liquidate its assets, and distribute the same among the certificate holders of the Units of Ownership according to the number of units held by them.

(B) For the purpose of winding up the affairs and liquidating the assets of the trust, the Trustee shall continue in office until such duties have been performed.
