REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE EXTENSION

I, the undersigned, do hereby covenant that I am the legal owners of Lot Nine (9) Block Ten (10), Highlands First Addition to the city of Tulsa, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the same being the premises conveyed to James K. Jones, Trustee by a certain real estate mortgage dated December 4, 1920 made by S. M. Farris (a single man) which mortgage is recorded in Book 265 page 105 in the Register's of Deeds office in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; said mortgage was given to secure the payment of a certain promissory note for the sum of \$2500.00 payable December 4, 1922, such note now payable to the order of/Estate of James K. Jones, Deceased, upon which note there remains unpaid the sum of \$1500.00 as principal money.

In consideration of the extension of the time for the payment thereof, for the term of Three years from maturity we hereby agree to pay interest on said principal sum as yet unpaid, from the day whereon the same, by the terms of the said note become due, at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, for and during said term of extension according
