ORDINANCE NO 2346.

COMPARED

An Ordinance vacating the East fifty (50) feet of Lansing Avenue between independence and King Streets with certain reservations and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it appears that Lansing Avenue between Independence Street and King Street is one hundred (100) feet wide and that at all other places Lansing Avenue is only fifty (50) feet wide, and

WHEREAS, Lansing Avenue between Independence and King Street is paved on the West half, and,

WHEREAS, the East fifty (50) feet of said street between Independence and King Streets is not needed for municipal purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1, That the East fifty (50) feet of Lansing Avenue between Independence and King streets, which Lansing Avenue runs north and south between Block 4, of Bullette Additions to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and Block 2, of Fairview Second Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, all in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa, County, State of Oklahoma as shown by the recorded plats thereof, and which strip of ground is more particularly described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Block 4 , Bullette Addition to the City of Tulsa, and going fifty feet west, thence due north 450 feet, thence due east fifty feet to the northwest corner of Block 4, Bullette Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, thence due south 450 feet along the west line of Block 4 Bullette, Addition to the City of Tulsa , Oklahoma, to the point of beginning.

be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned as part of the public street of said City, provided however, that the City of Tulsa hereby reserves and shall retain forever the right to
