That these affiants on October 6, 1919 obtained a mortgage from the Aetna Loan Association for Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) on said Lots Forty-five (45) and Forty-six (46), above described and gave therefore a mortgage in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) which was recorded on the same date inthe office of the County Clerk and appears in book 299 at page 349 in said office.

Affiants further state that they bought and purchased, from Dimer R. Wells and received a deed therefor on June 3, 1921, lot No. Forty-four (44) above described, which said deed was recorded on June 15, 1921 in the office of the county Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklähoma, and appears in book 366 at page 347.
