OKLAHOMA MORTGAGE

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 2nd day of Dec. in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty two, by and between Percoz T. Thomas and Geo. T. Thomas, her husband of the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and The First National Bank of Sand Springs part--- of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand DOLLARS, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, and to its heirs and assigns, forever, all of the following described tract, piece or parcel of land, lying and situate in Sand Springs County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Lot Thirty Eight (38) in Block (45) Forty Five, of the original town of Sand Springs

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and all rights of homestead exemption, unto the said party of the second part, and to its heirs and assigns, forever. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances except
