DECLARATION OF TRUST ESTATE

Known as

THE TEXMEX OIL COMPANY

Article I.

WHEREAS, we, Paul W. Smith, of Waterloo, Iowa, and A. T. Jergins, of Fort Worth, Texas, are engaged in the business of mining, producing and marketing of petroleum and its products, and are the holders of the legal title to the following property, real, mixed and personal:

An undivided one-half interest in the Lizzie Queen lease, Eastland county, Texas, to-wit:

Fifteen acres of land, designated as lot No. 2 in that certain decree of the district Court of Eastland County, Texas, in cause styled Mrs. Zulu Horton vs. Mrs. N. O. Beardon No. 4827 on the docket of said court, rendered on the 20th day of November, 1918, in which said decree said fifteen (15) acres of land is set apart and awarded to Lizzie Queen (nee Beardon) said land being fully described by metes and bounds in said decree, to which reference is here made for further description of said land; and also certain other lands in said original lease fully described. Said lease being recorded in the office of the register of deeds in and for said county in Book 129, page 70, et seq. and insofar as it covers the property herein assigned.

Also commercial lease form 88 on 160 acres in Comanche County, Texas, described as follows:
